Mid Year Exam Schedule January 2019

Mid year exams will be held during the week of January 21st. Second Quarter grades close on Tuesday, January 22, 2019. Exams will begin on Tuesday, January 22, 2019 and end on Friday, January 25, 2019. Exams will be scheduled to last one hour and fifteen minutes.

Tuesday, 1/22/19 (Day 5) will be a full day of school with an exam given during **G period (4th period)**, which is the long block in the schedule.

Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday, will be early release days with 2 exam periods scheduled for each day.

STUDENTS ARE TO STAY AWAY FROM ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS ON THE DAYS ON WHICH WE HAVE EARLY RELEASE FROM EXAMS.

During the ½ days:

- Any student scheduled for Physical Education/Project Adventure/ Guidance Seminar on an exam day, who does not have their own transportation, must report **to the cafe** for a study.
- If a student has a **study** scheduled during an exam period, he/she is to **report to the cafeteria for the study.**
- Students arriving late will need to sign in at the office. A pass will be given from the office to go to their exam or cafeteria.
- BUSES will leave school at 10:45 on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. There are no late busses on any of these days.
- Students with their own transportation and who have only a first period exam may leave when they have completed the exam on these days. Students without their own transportation, who have no exam during second period, are to report to the café for directed study. All students who are not scheduled for an exam first period are to report to the cafeteria for directed study during the examination. Any student with his own transportation who is not scheduled for a first period exam is to report to the main office for attendance upon arrival to school. This attendance record will not reflect a tardy.

Admit late students who have a pass from the office to your exam within reason. Otherwise, students will require a make-up exam. Make-up exams will be given only after presenting an authorization slip from the main office. It is the students' responsibility to contact his/her teacher to make arrangements for a make-up.

Exams must be given unless cleared with program coordinators/assistant principals.

Keep all students in examination room until the end of the test period. Tell students to bring something to read if they finish their exam early. Students should not be in the halls for any reason.

Students are required to attend all scheduled exams. Cutting exams will be treated as a class cut and disciplinary action will be taken. Students who cut an exam forfeit their right to take a make-up exam.

Students who do not take a scheduled semester exam will receive a zero for the exam.

Since there are no busses after 10:45 am, clubs, teams, groups, etc., will not meet unless students have their own arranged transportation.

The last day to take a make- up exam is Friday, January 25th from 11:50-2:13.
Second semester courses will begin on Monday, January 28, 2019 (Day 2)
