Students must stay in exam rooms or the cafeteria until the end of the period, and are not to be in the halls for any reason. Students should bring all necessary study materials with them at the start of the period.

Exams last one hour and fifteen minutes (except on Tuesday, January 21, where the exam period is 72 minutes)

In order for a student to take a make-up exam, he/she must receive authorization from an assistant principal. If a make-up exam has been approved, teachers will be notified. It will then be the student's responsibility to contact his/her teacher to arrange for a make-up time

Cutting an exam is treated as cutting a class. Students who cut an exam forfeit their right to take a make-up exam.

Students who do not take a scheduled semester exam will receive a zero for the exam.

The **last day** to take a make-up exam is Friday, January 24th from 11:50 - 2:13.

Teams, clubs, etc. do not meet until 2:13.

On the ½ days:

- Students are to report to their scheduled exam room/cafeteria at 7:42 each day.
- From 7:42 - 8:00 a.m. attendance should be taken and students should use the time for study and preparation.
- Students arriving late need to sign in at the office. A pass will be given from the office to go to their exam or scheduled class.
- Students with their own transportation and who have only a first period exam may leave when the exam period is over on these days. Students without their own transportation, who have no exam during second period, are to go to the cafeteria for a study. All students who are not scheduled for an exam first period are to report to the cafe during the examination. Any student with his own transportation who is not scheduled for a first period exam is to report to the main office for attendance upon arrival to school.
- Any student scheduled for physical education/guidance seminar on a ½ day exam day, who does not have their own transportation, must report to the CAFETERIA for a study.
- Buses will leave school at 10:45 on Wed., Thurs., Fri. (half days).

Students are to stay away from elementary schools on the half-day afternoons.
