The information below is an annual notice required by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts for any buildings that potentially have asbestos in the building materials due to the age of construction. As required by law, this notice is being provided to all parents, guardians, and staff members of the Pine Grove School and the Triton Middle/High School. This requirement does not apply to Newbury Elementary and Salisbury Elementary Schools as these buildings were certified not to contain asbestos-containing building material (ACBM) at the time of building/renovation.

## Occupant Annual AHERA Notification

The Pine Grove School and the Triton Middle / High School building has had a recent inspection for asbestos-containing building material (ACBM) in accordance with 40 CFR Part 763, Asbestos Hazards Emergency Response Act (AHERA). ACBM is present in these school buildings and is being managed safely in accordance with state and federal standards. Asbestos Management Plan documents have been prepared for the buildings and are available for review at the main office of each school and at the District Office. The condition of the ACBM is reviewed every six months.
